

Anti-mite bed covers Protection against dust-mite allergy Care and use instructions Please read before use!

Special use instructions

- For hygienic reasons, WELLline® anti-mite bed covers must be washed before using.
- WELLline[®] anti-mite bed covers are used as encasings under usual bed cover.
- After washing, the anti-mite bed covers must be completely dry before using.
- As a security, the inside zip protection must cover properly the zipper.
- There should be no sharp-edged object in contact with the anti-mite bed covers.
- Please pay attention that the right size of anti-mite bed covers is used.
- Anti-mite bed covers must be stored away from children.
- Please, wash anti-mite bed covers with zipper open.
- To avoid risk of asphyxiation, please keep the packaging bags away from children.

Term of use

• Anti-mite bed covers can be washed as often as necessary. By strong allergic reactions, it is advisable to wash the anti-mite bed covers every three months.

Care instructions

Anti-mite bed covers can be washed with usual detergents in the washing machine.



Temperature: For ecologic and economic reasons, washing at $60^\circ\!\!C$ is adequate and advisable



Whitening: chloric whitening is possible

Laundry dryer: dryable in laundry dryer

Ironing: iron at mild temperature

By following the above written instructions, anti-mite bed covers can be used for a longer time.

Storing advice

- Anti-mite bed covers must not be in contact with open fire.
- Please avoid direct contact with other heating sources.

<u>Risks</u>

• By covering anti-mite bed covers overhead there is a danger of suffocation!
